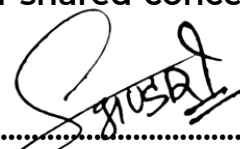

- Suspended from all GGSRC activities, events, meetings, and official representations for a period of 15 (fifteen) days, effective from 3/4/2026 to 3/19/2026

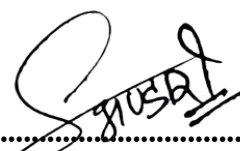
